Foundation Scholarship

Requirements/Guidelines

Must be...

- 1 – a member of TQHYA, term of membership taken into consideration;
- 2 – at least one parent or legal guardian must be a member of TQHA;
- 3 – a US citizen and Texas resident;
- 4 – a graduating senior or already enrolled in a Texas-accredited US college or university;
- 5 – available to volunteer 30 hours per year at TQHA events [including but not limited to: Texas Classic, Texas Amateur Championship Show, TQHA All-Novice Shows];
- 6 – available for an interview

Recipients will be chosen on the basis of academic records, demonstrated leadership, financial need, and extracurricular accomplishments with emphasis on participation in TQHYA, AQHYA, 4-H, FFH and/or High School Rodeo involvement; Scholarships will be four year awards (not to exceed four years); Scholarships will continue as long as the recipient is a full-time student in general good standing & GPA 2.0 or higher (student must send a transcript each semester to TQHA); Amount of the scholarship can range from \$500 to \$1500 per year; Recipient must attend a Texas accredited US college or university; Recipient must send a letter of progress to TQHA each semester,

Must submit...

- 1 – Scholarship Application;
- 2 - Essay of no more than 500 words explaining "How the American Quarter Horse has affected my life and influenced my future.";
- 3 - Two(2) letters of recommendation;
- 4 - Intended Career path & chosen college/university;
- 5 - Most recent transcript;
- 6 - Recent photo.
